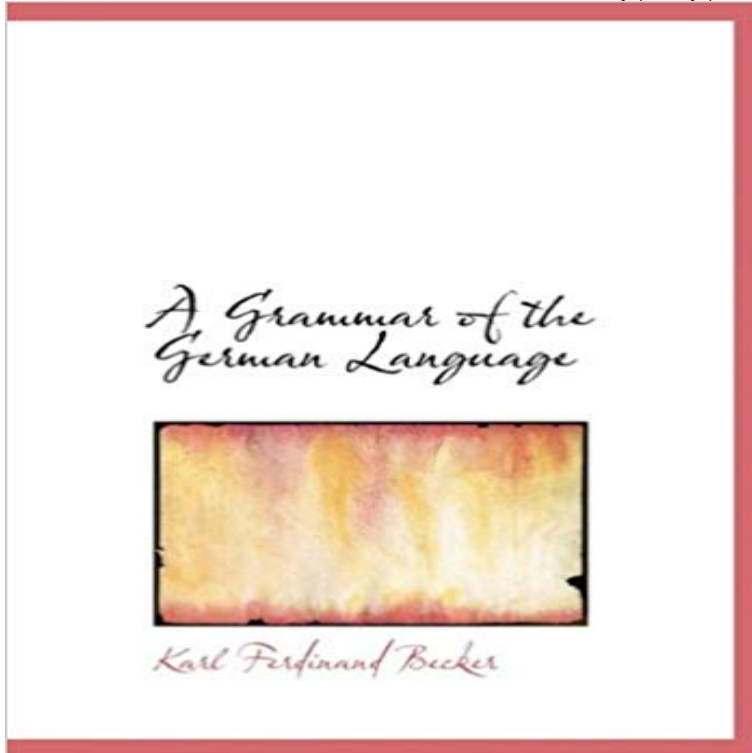


## A Grammar of the German Language
