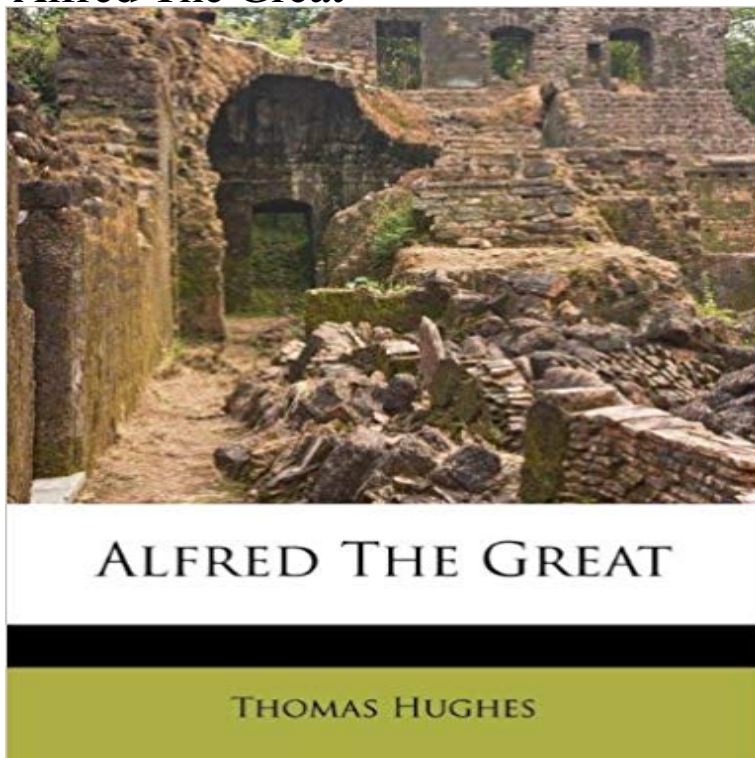


# Alfred The Great
