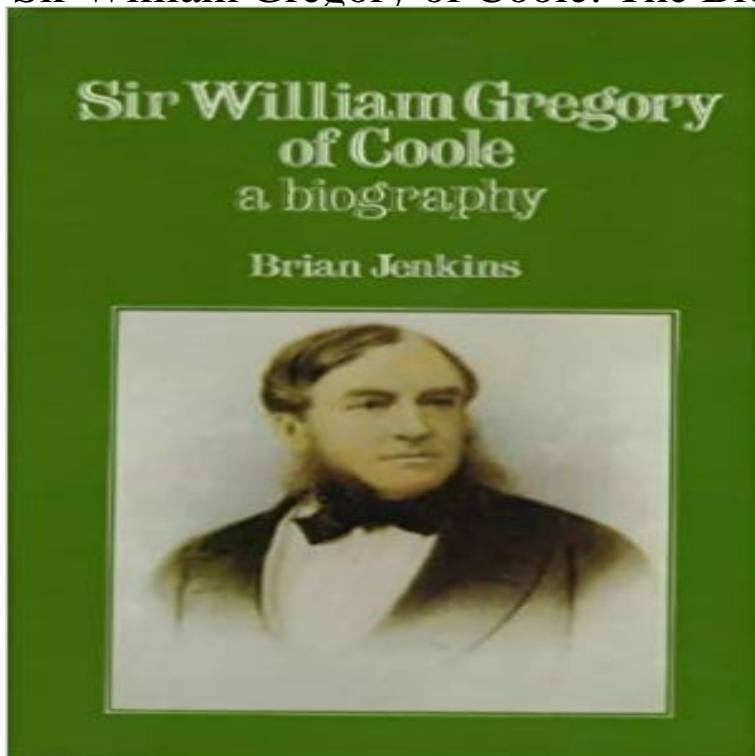


## Sir William Gregory of Coole: The Biography of an Anglo-Irishman
