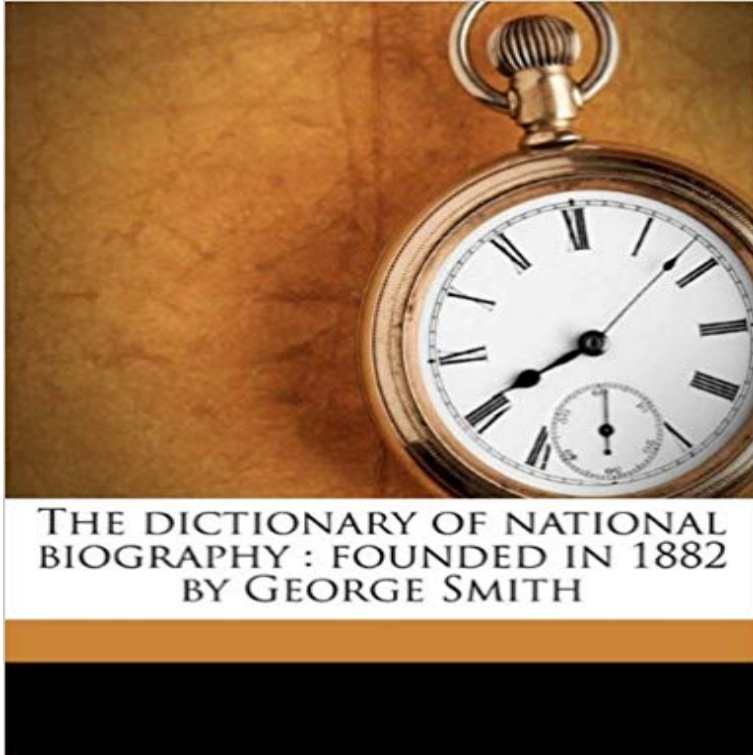


The dictionary of national biography: founded in 1882 by George Smith Volume 1, Pt.3
