
Bourdieu in International Relations: Rethinking Key Concepts in IR (New International Relations)

The last few years have seen a genuine wave of publications promoting sociology international relations. Scholars have suggested that Bourdieus vocabulary can be applied to study security, diplomacy, migration and global environmental politics. Yet we still lack a systematic and accessible analysis of Bourdieu-inspired IR might look like. This book provides the answer. It offers an introduction to Bourdieus thinking to a wider IR audience, challenges key assumptions, which currently structure IR scholarship and provides an original, theoretical restatement of some of the core concepts in the field. Each chapter covers one central concept in IR: Methodology, Knowledge, Power. Strategy, Security, Culture, Gender. Norms, Sovereignty andIntegration. The chapters demonstrate how these concepts can be reinterpreted and used in new ways when exposed to Bourdieusian logic.
