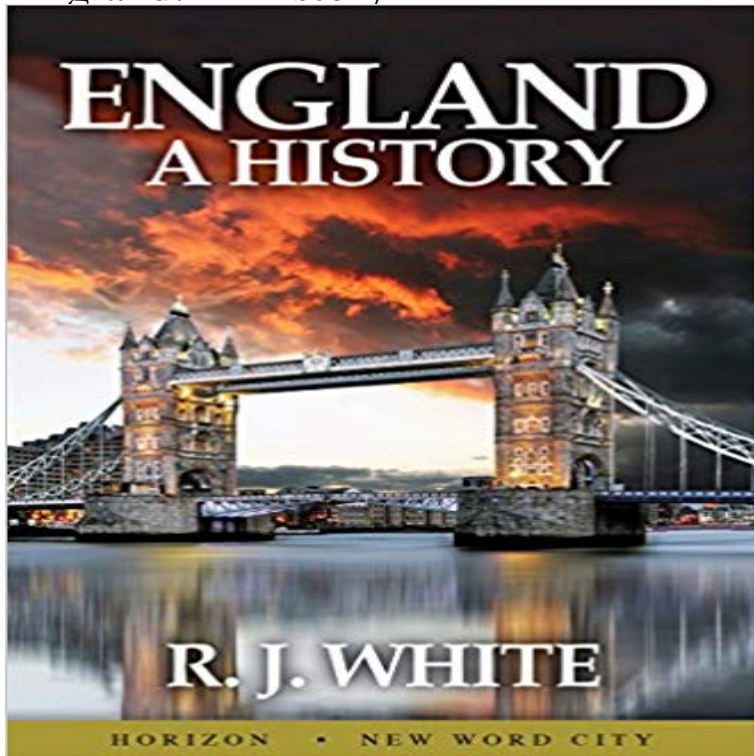


England: A History
