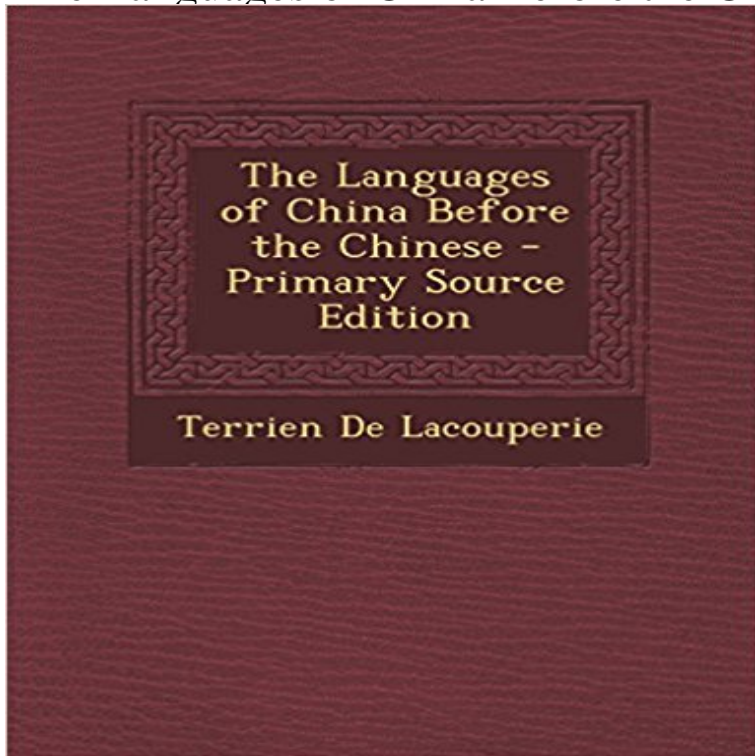


The Languages of China Before the Chinese
