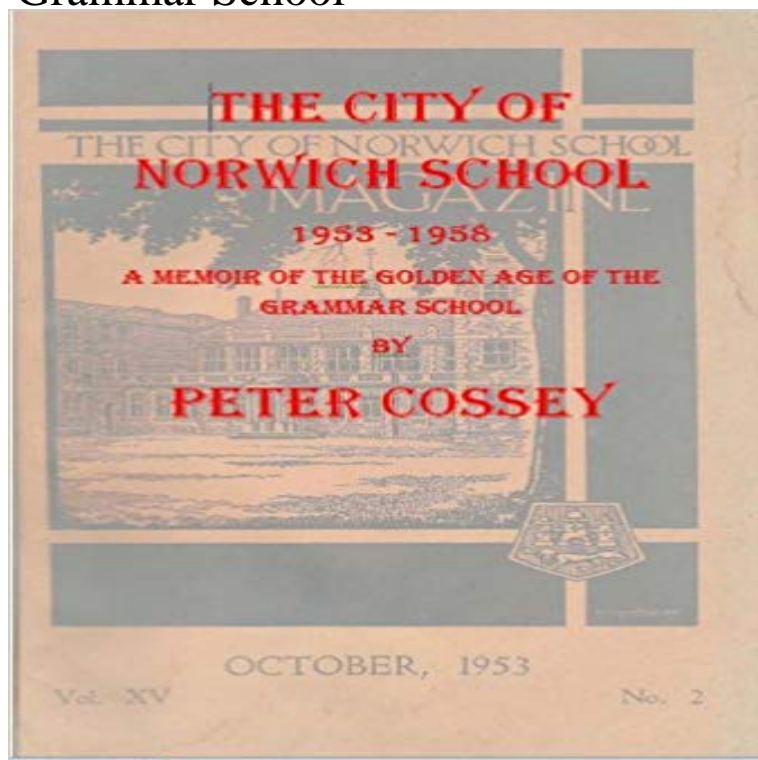


The City of Norwich School A Memoir of the Golden Age of the Grammar School

Norwich had its one proud public academic institution that had stood, at the time of this memoir, for fifty years, but which was already facing a changing world that would soon change its essentially pre-war character and ethos forever. This personal story of five years at the end of an era describes some of the personalities, and indicates the changing attitudes of a turbulent post war world.
