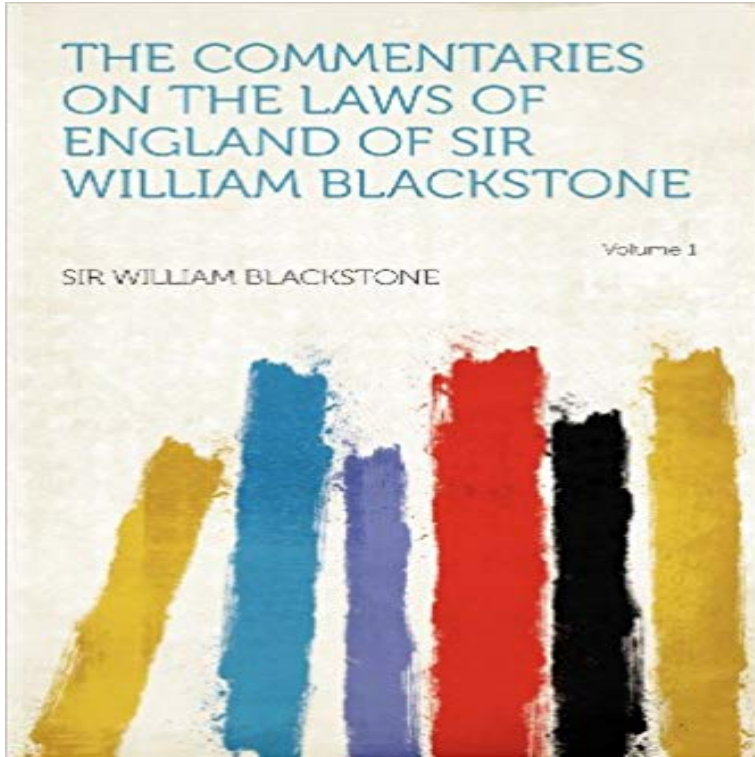


The Commentaries on the Laws of England of Sir William Blackstone Volume 1
