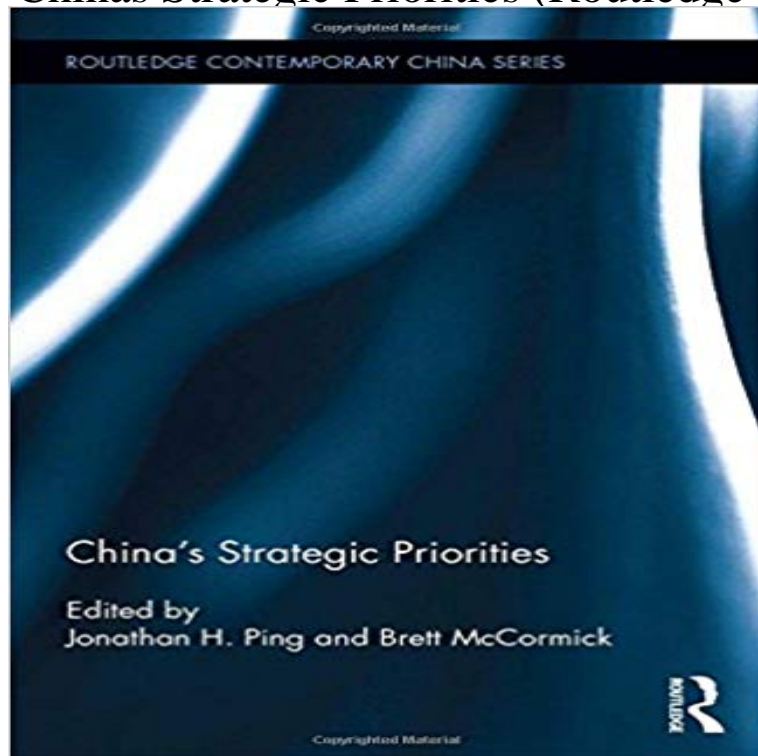


Chinas Strategic Priorities (Routledge Contemporary China Series)
