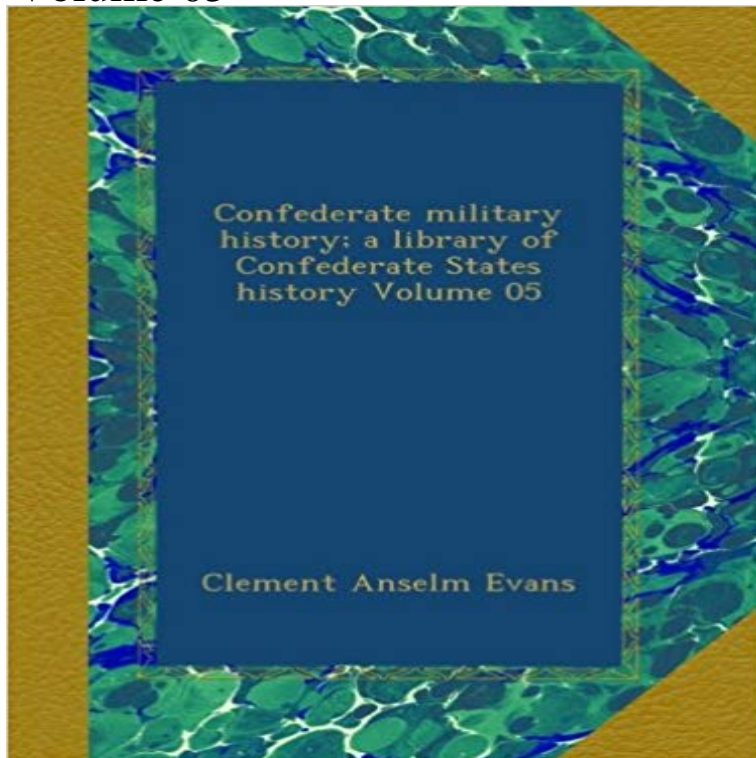


Confederate military history; a library of Confederate States history Volume 05
