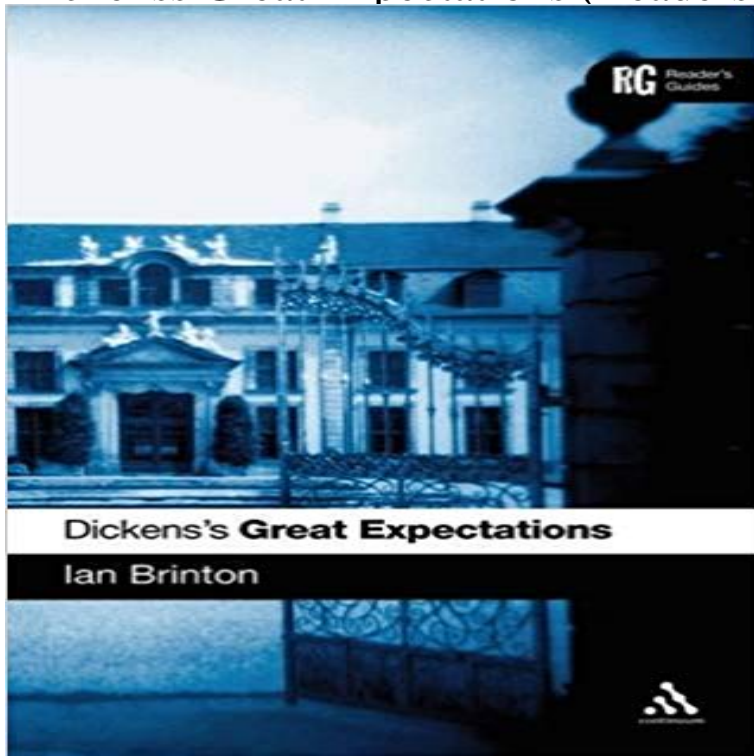


Dickens Great Expectations (Readers Guides)
