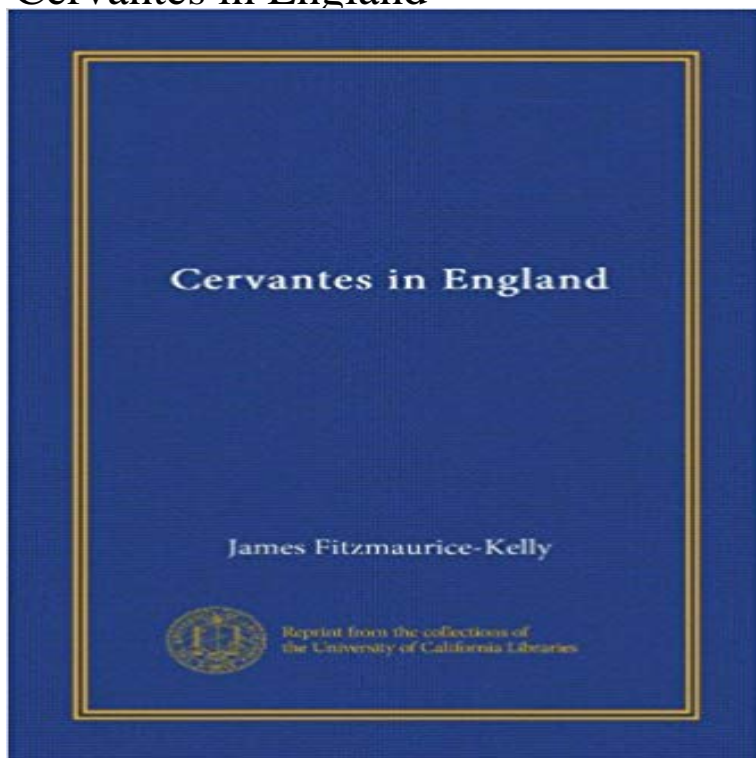


Cervantes in England
