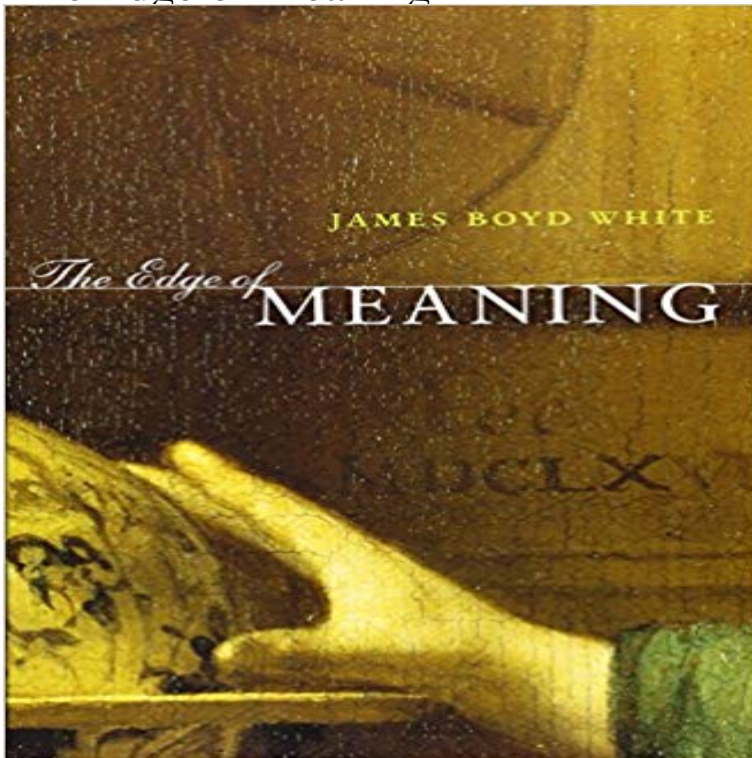


The Edge of Meaning
