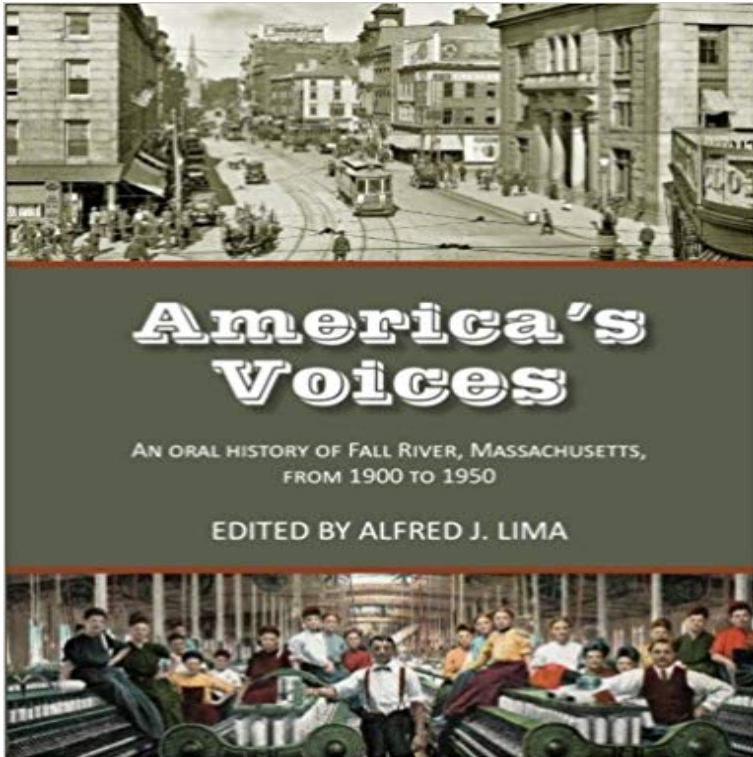


Americas Voices: An Oral History of Fall River, Massachusetts, from 1900 to 1950
