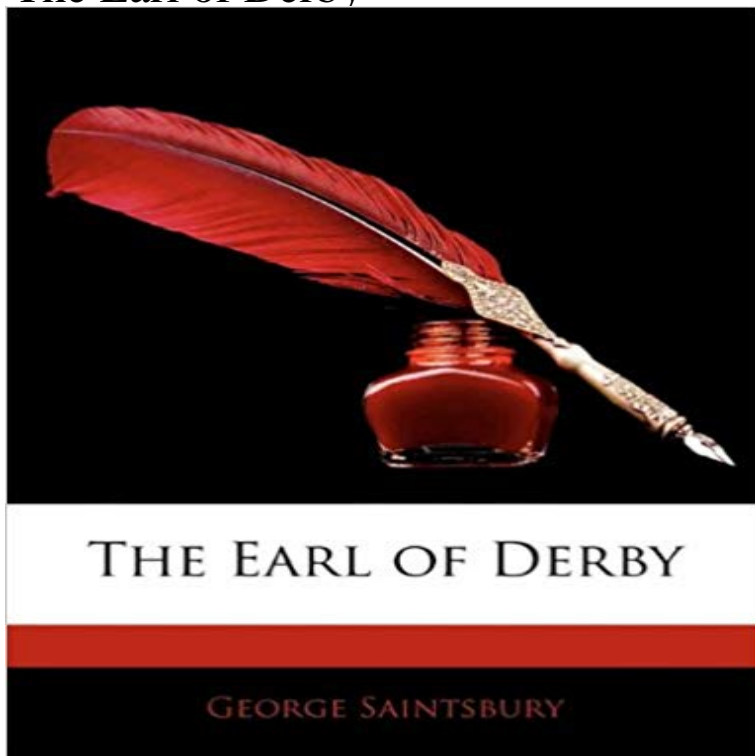


The Earl of Derby
