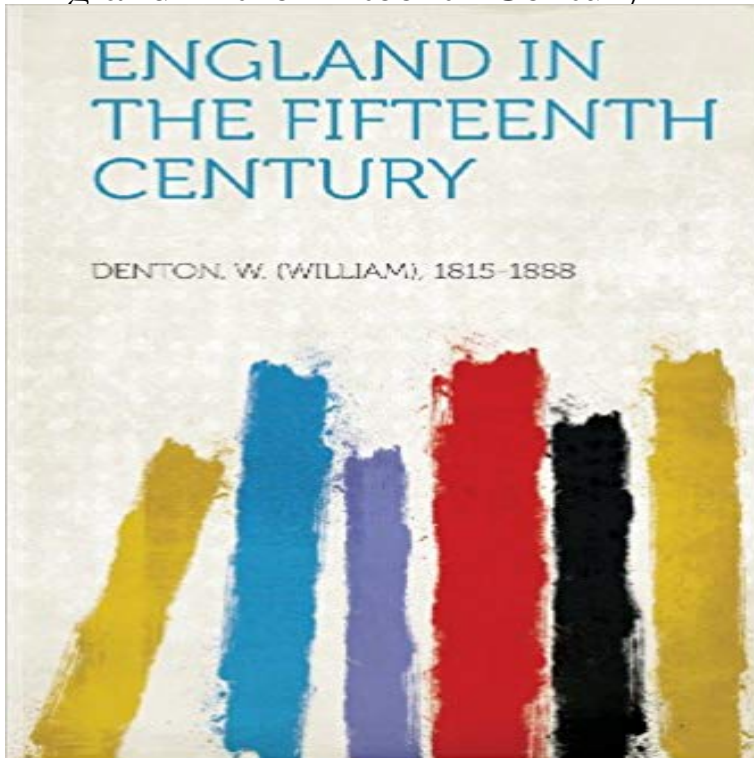


## England in the Fifteenth Century
