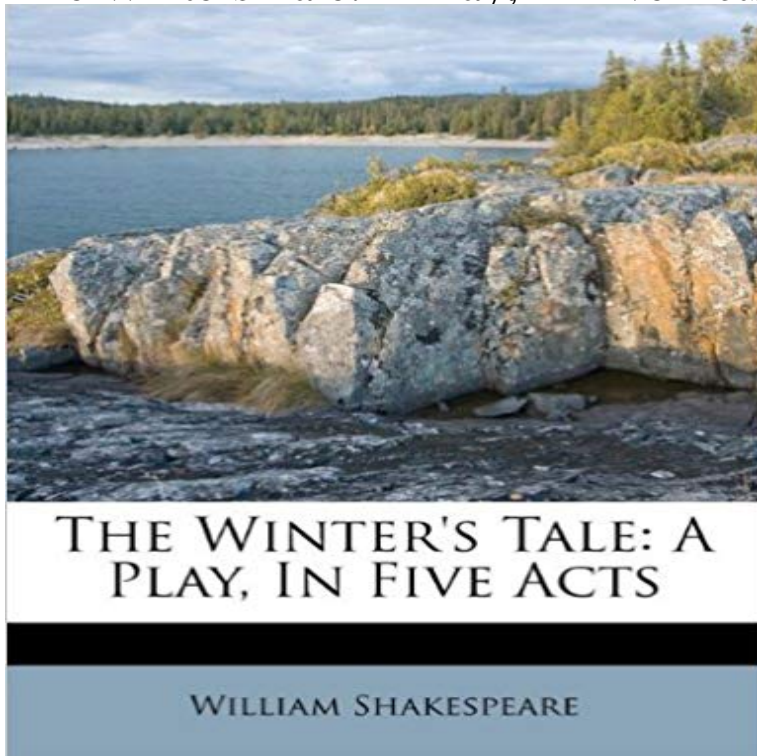


# The Winters Tale: A Play, In Five Acts
