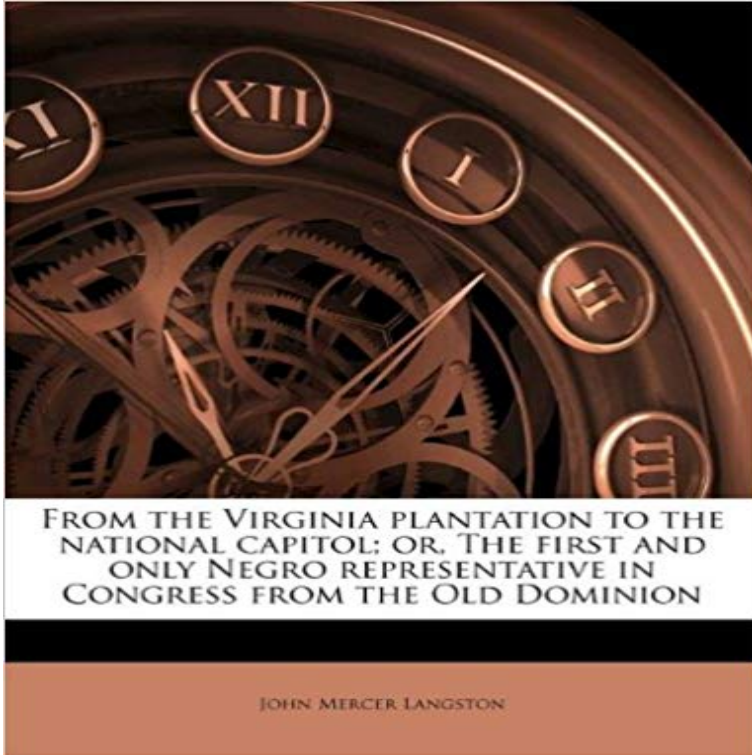


From the Virginia plantation to the national capitol; or, The first and only Negro representative in Congress from the Old Dominion
