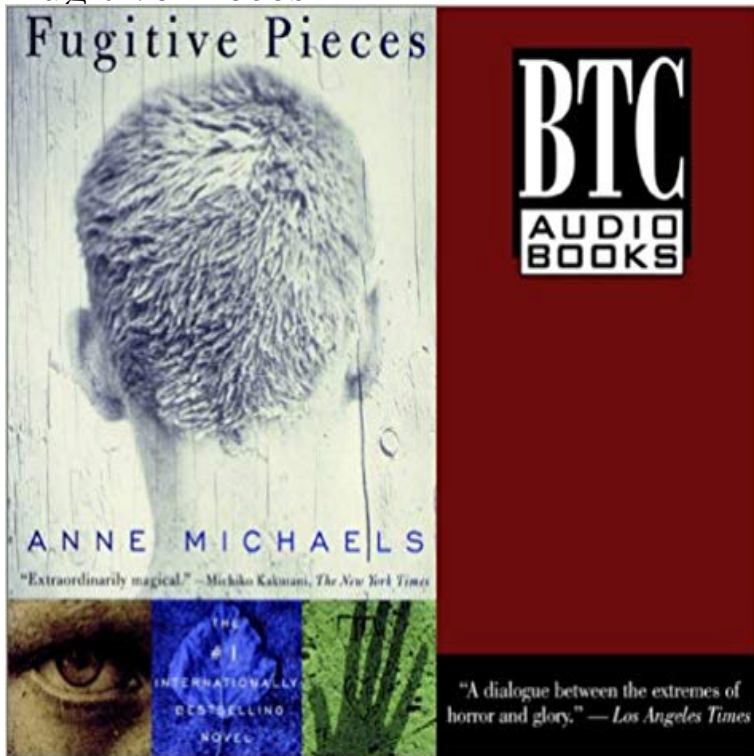


Fugitive Pieces
