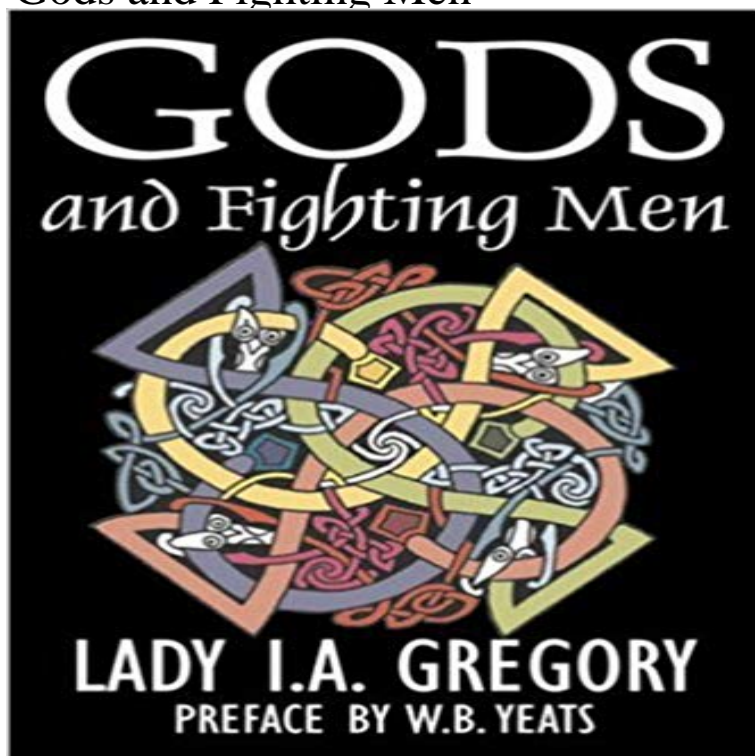


Gods and Fighting Men



Lady Gregory produced a number of books of retellings of stories taken from Irish mythology. Born into a class that identified closely with British rule, her conversion to cultural nationalism, as evidenced by her writings, was emblematic of many of the political struggles to occur in Ireland during her lifetime. From the battles of Nuada, king of the Tuatha de Danaan, to the arrival of St. Patrick, Lady Gregory presents the great tales of Ireland, telling them faithfully with the voice of the Irish countryside -- in the manner of the thatched houses. The Gods return to a divine country . . . In the woods of Slieve Bladhma a boy was reared in secrecy, and taught the skills of the woods and the court.
