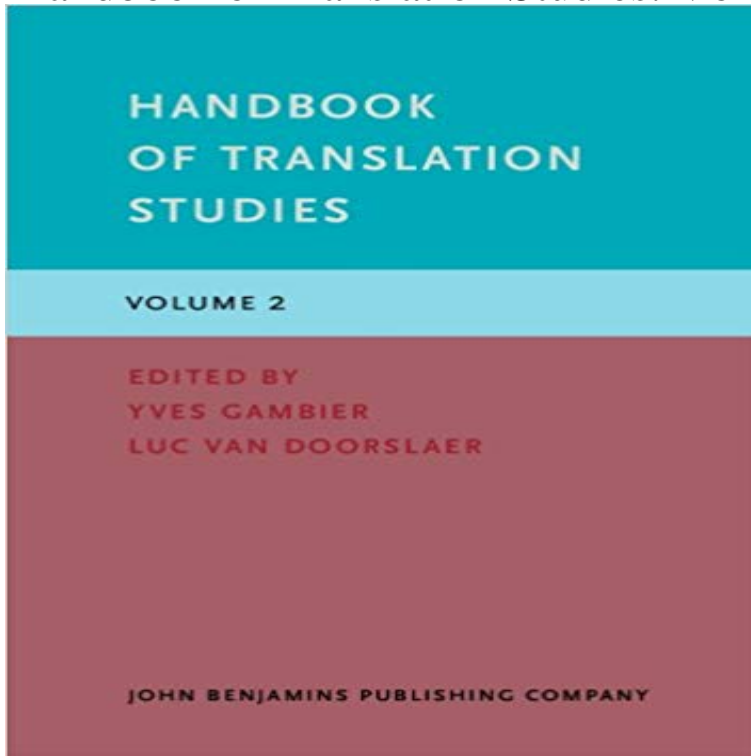


Handbook of Translation Studies: Volume 2
