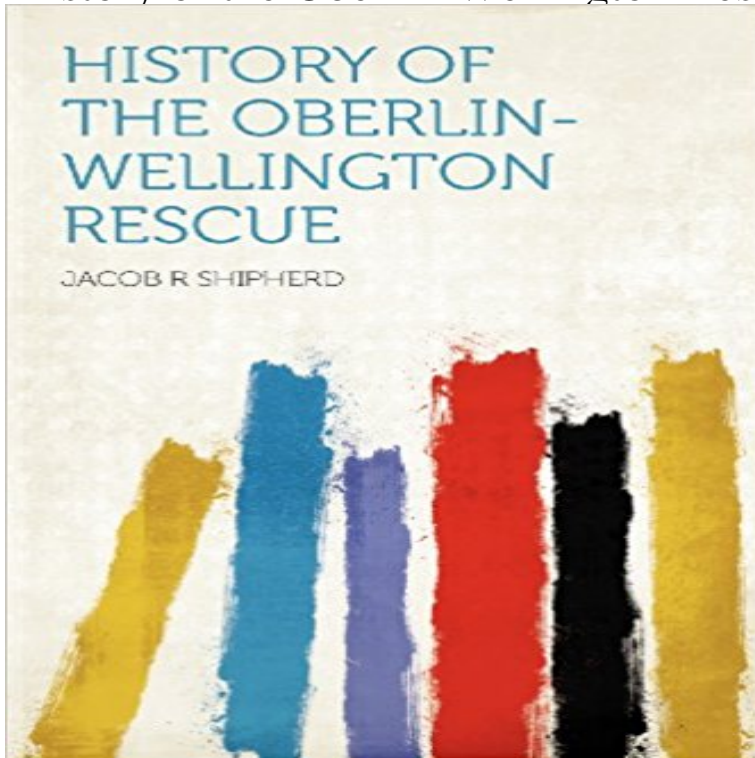


History of the Oberlin-Wellington Rescue
