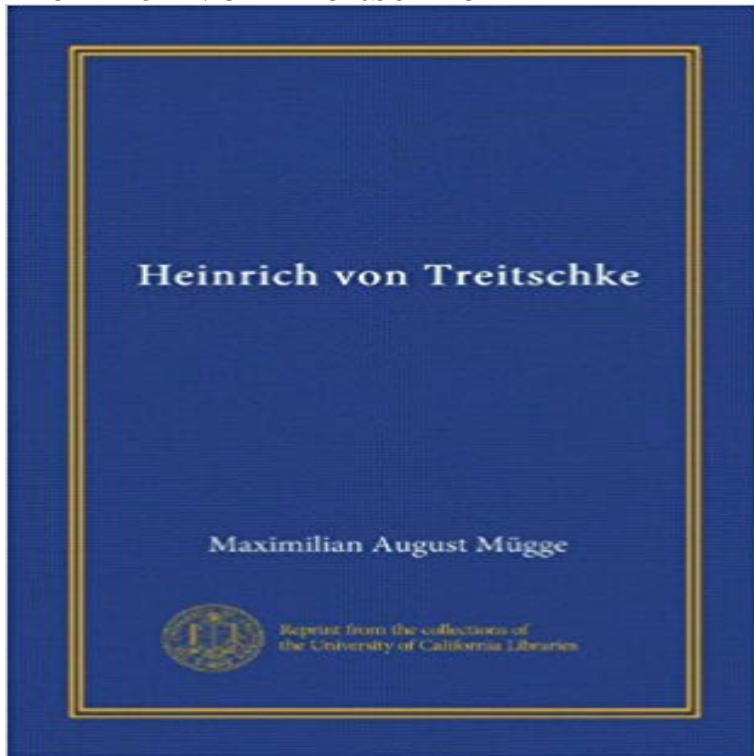


Heinrich von Treitschke
