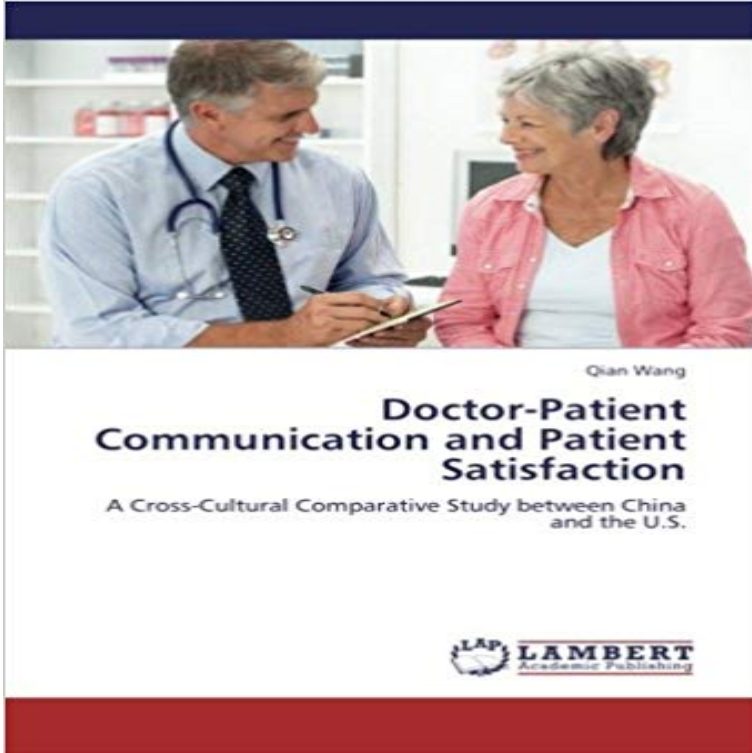


# Doctor-Patient Communication and Patient Satisfaction: A Cross-Cultural Comparative Study between China and the U.S.
