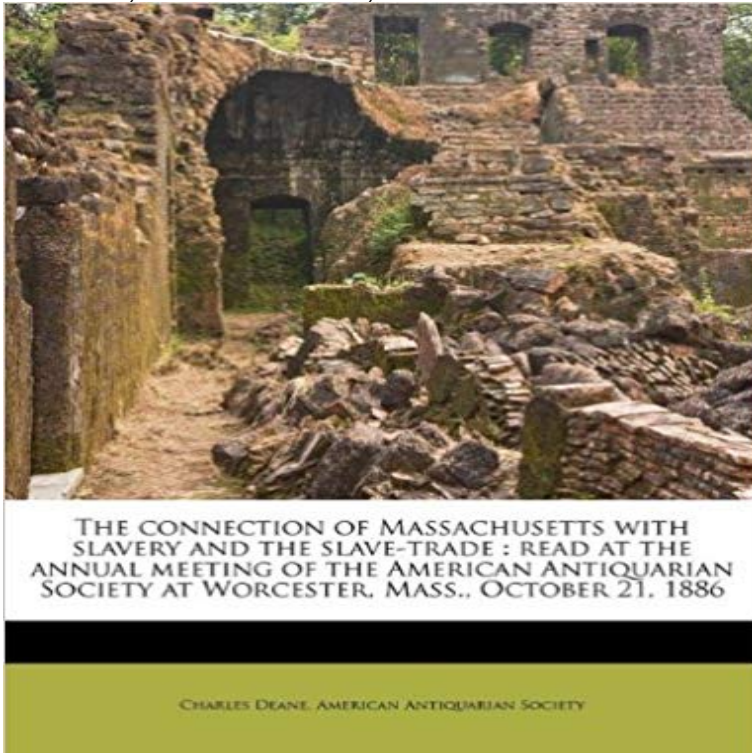


The connection of Massachusetts with slavery and the slave-trade: read at the annual meeting of the American Antiquarian Society at Worcester, Mass., October 21, 1886
