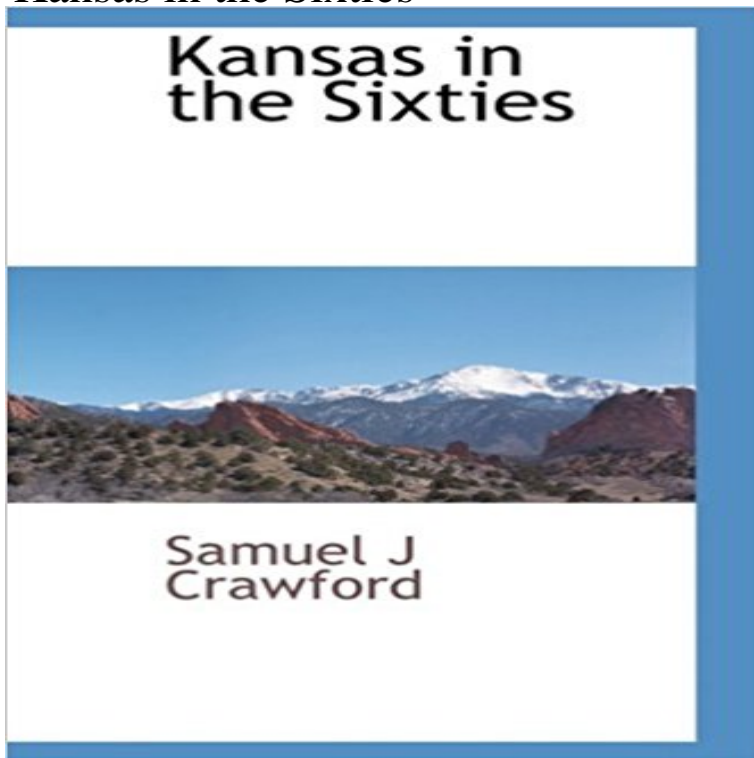


## Kansas in the Sixties
