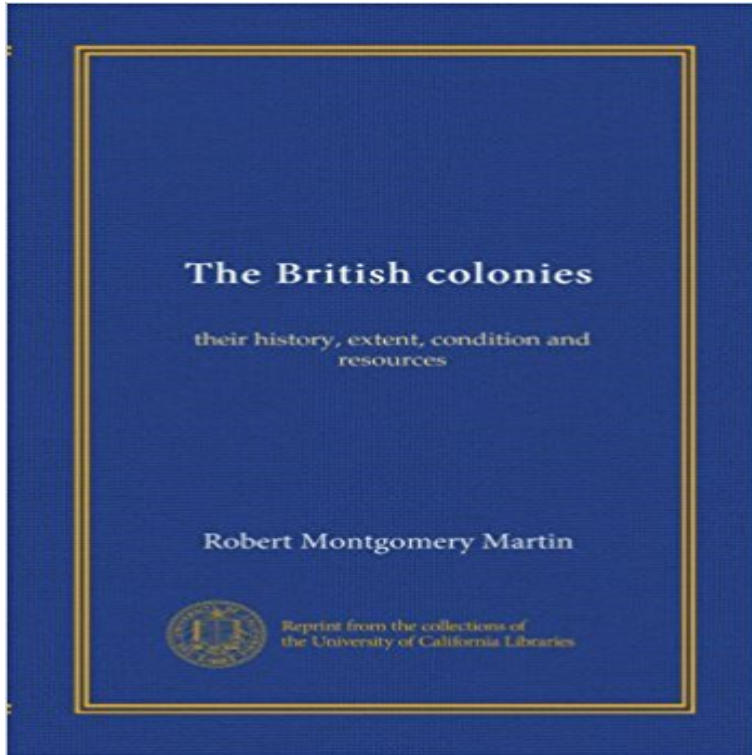


# The British colonies (v.005): their history, extent, condition and resources
