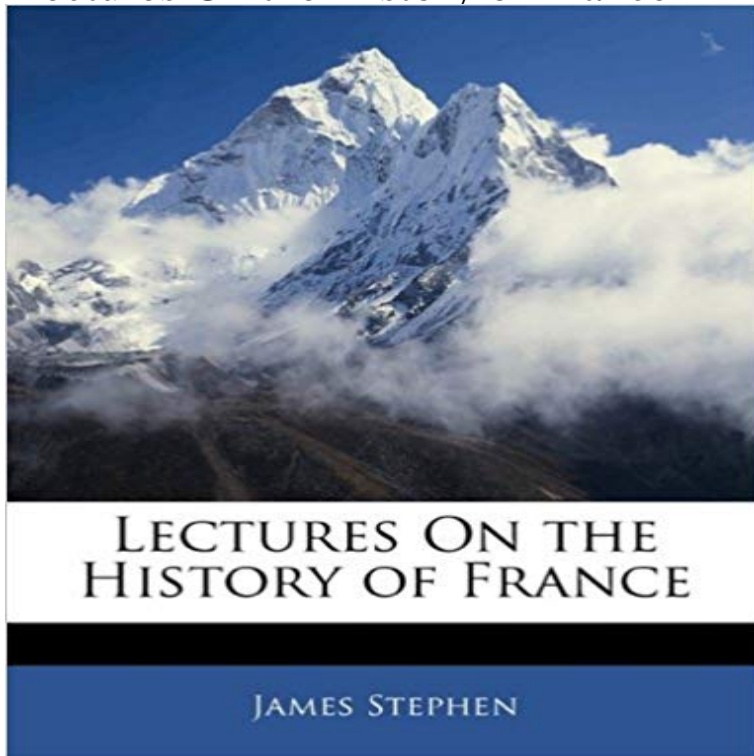


Lectures On the History of France
