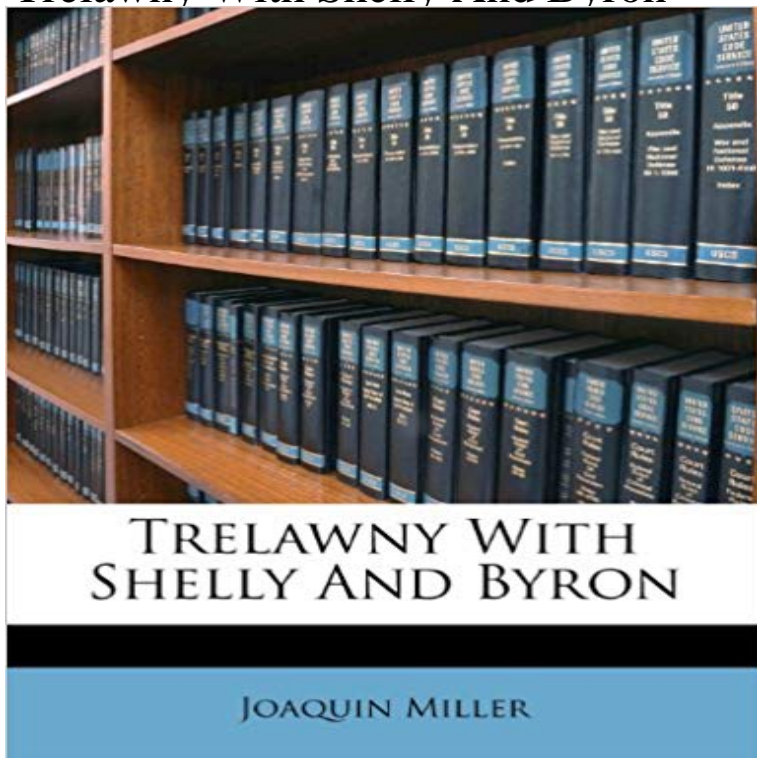


# Trelawny With Shelly And Byron
