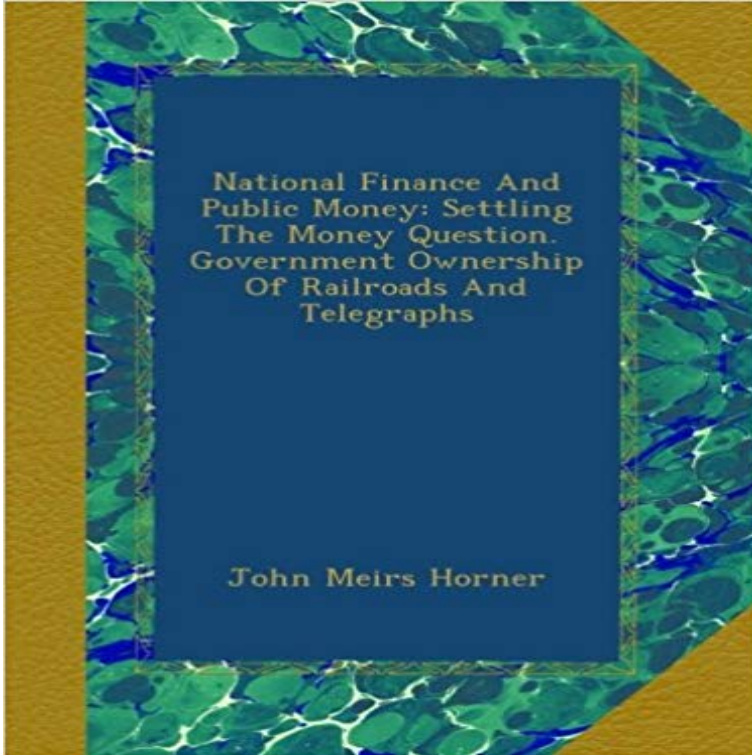


# National Finance And Public Money: Settling The Money Question. Government Ownership Of Railroads And Telegraphs
