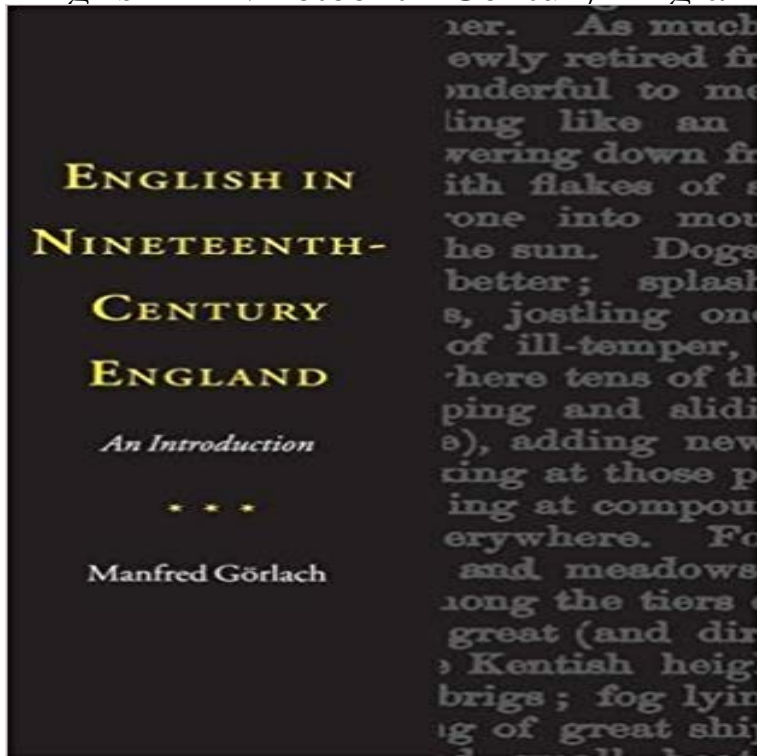


English in Nineteenth-Century England: An Introduction
