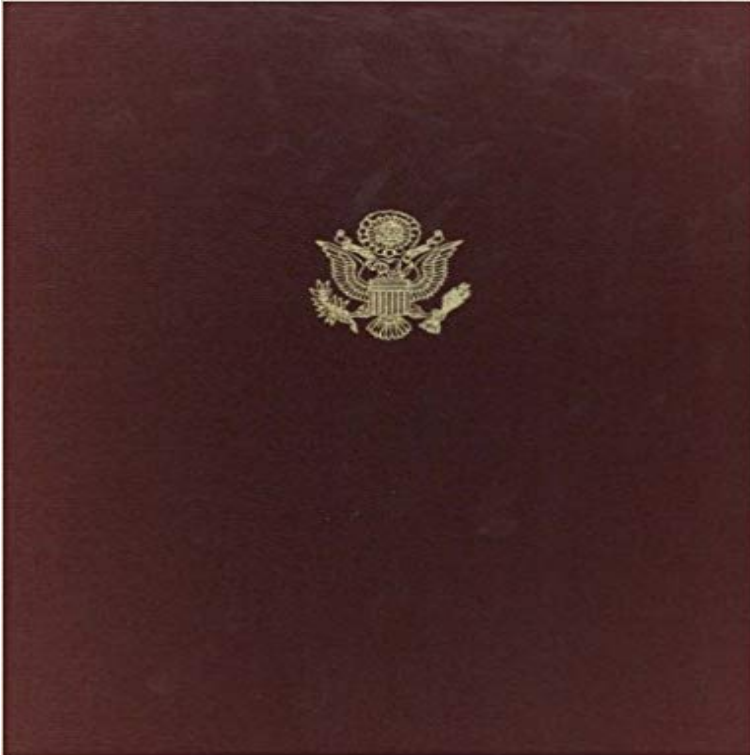


JAPANESE OPERATIONS IN THE SOUTHWEST PACIFIC AREA, VOLUME II, PART I (Part 3 of 3)
