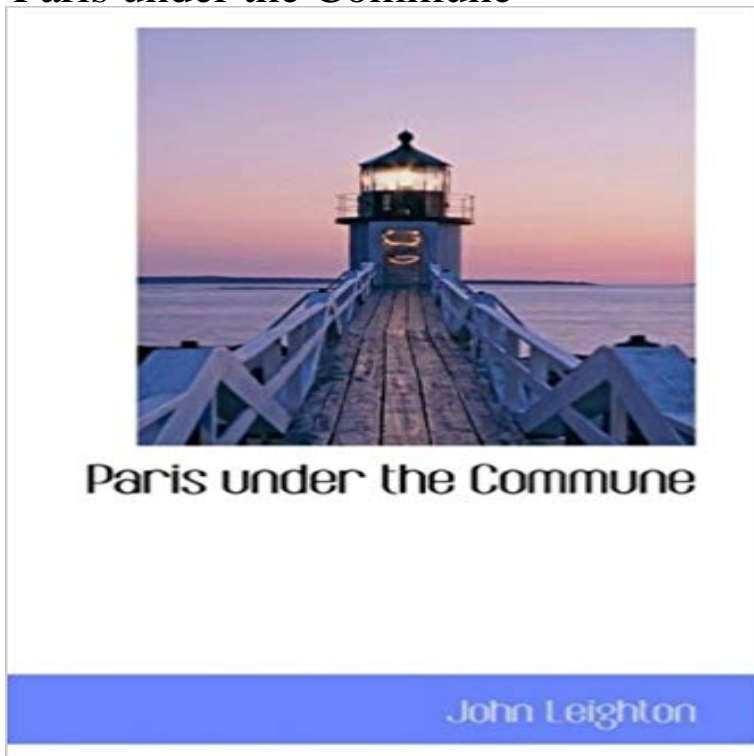


Paris under the Commune
