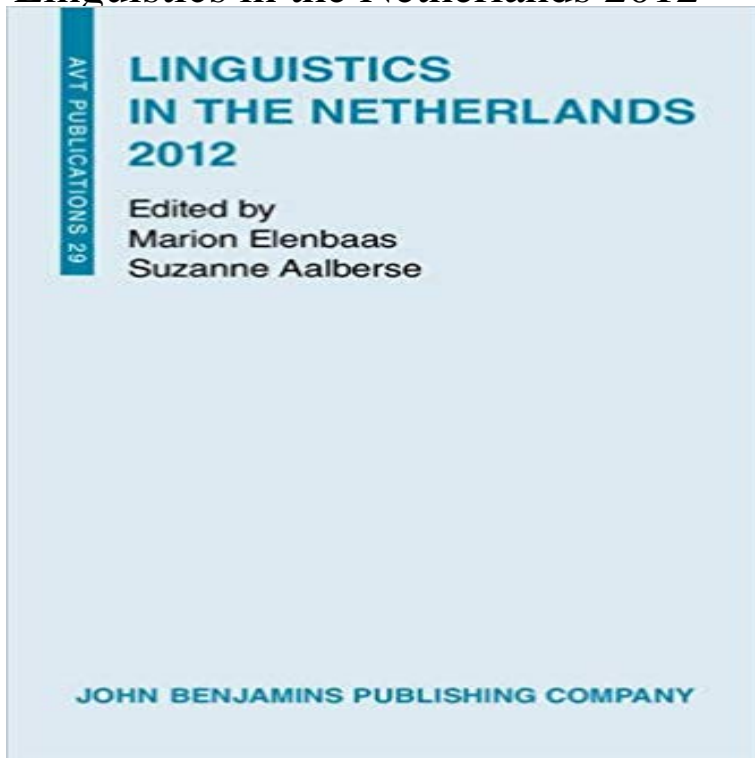


Linguistics in the Netherlands 2012
