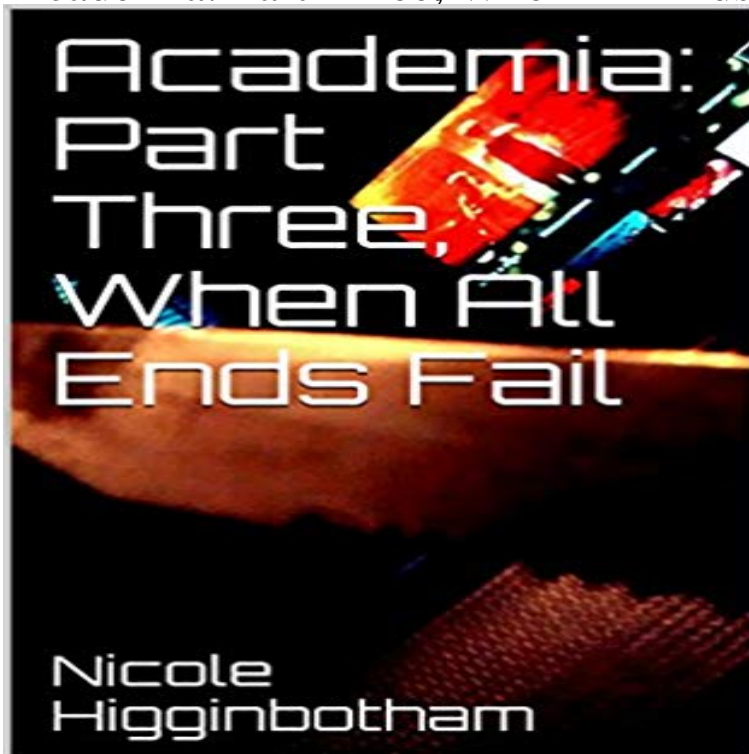


Academia: Part Three, When All Ends Fail
