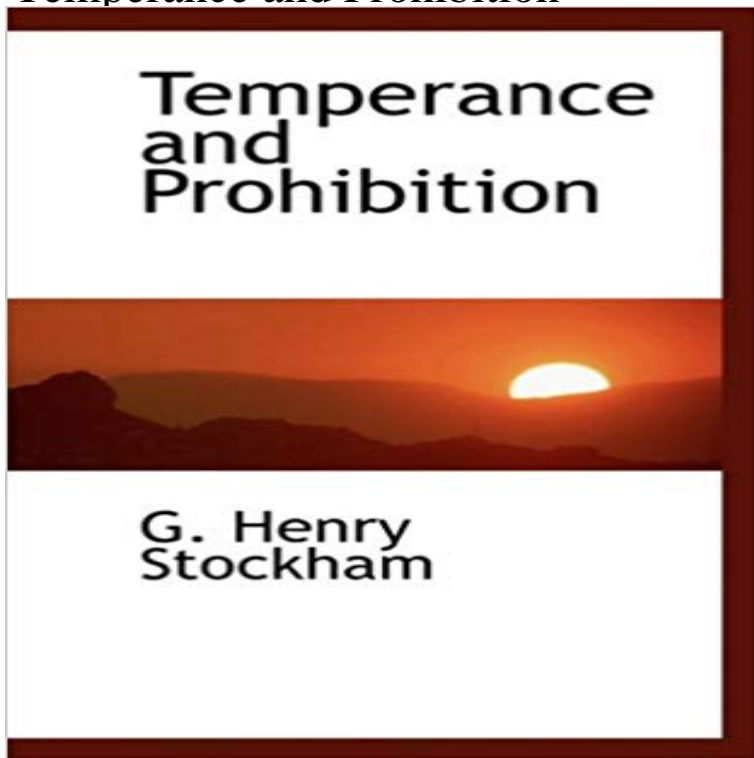


Temperance and Prohibition
