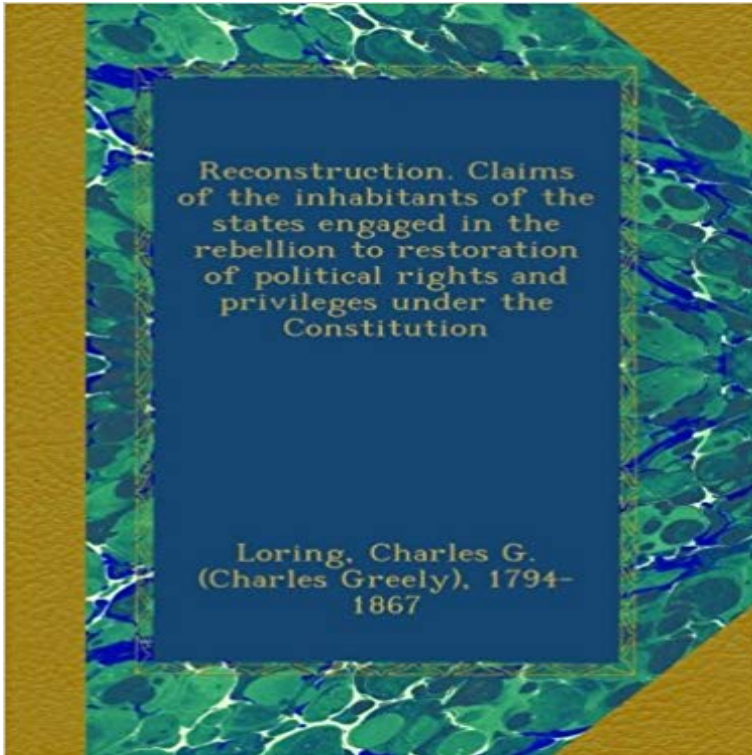


Reconstruction. Claims of the inhabitants of the states engaged in the rebellion to restoration of political rights and privileges under the Constitution
