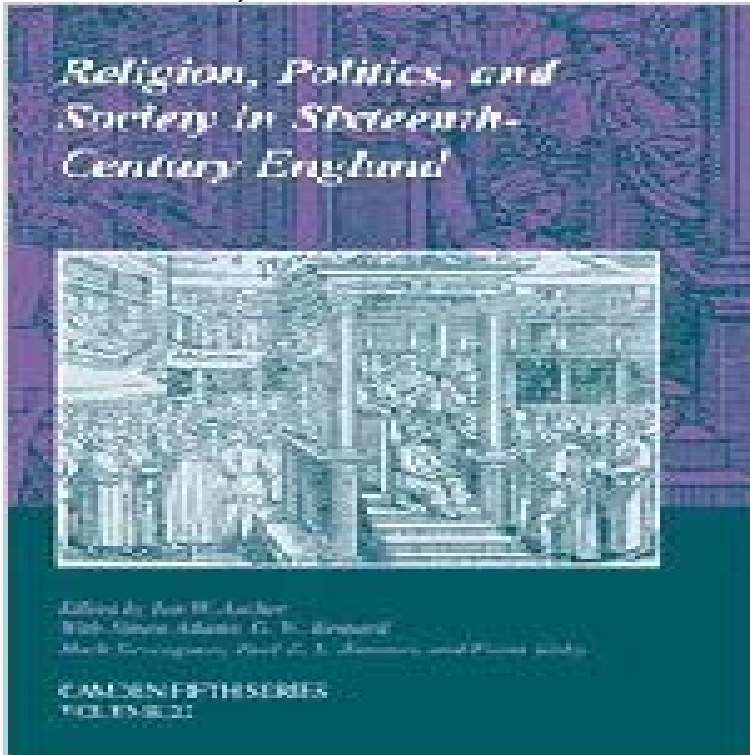


Religion, Politics, and Society in Sixteenth-Century England (Camden Fifth Series)
