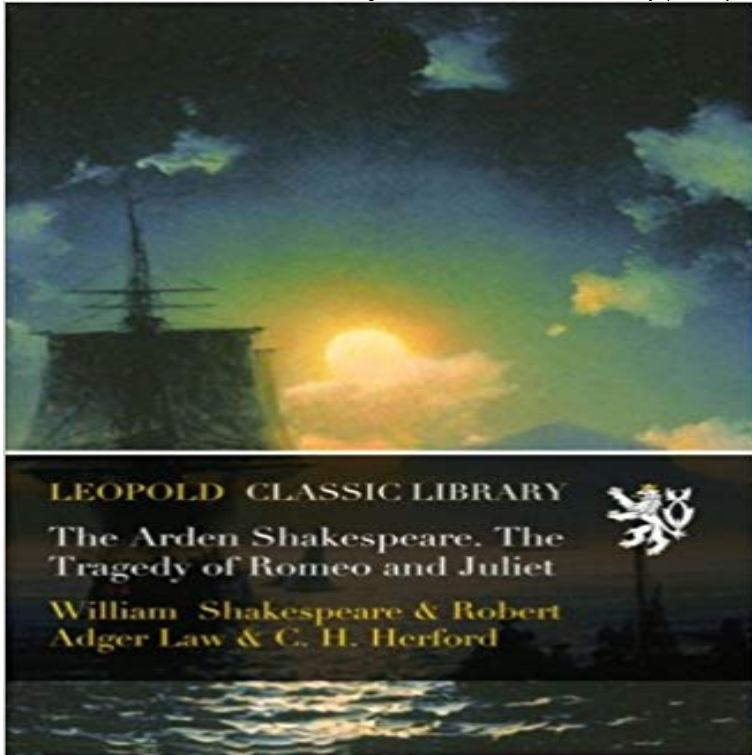


The Arden Shakespeare. The Tragedy of Romeo and Juliet
