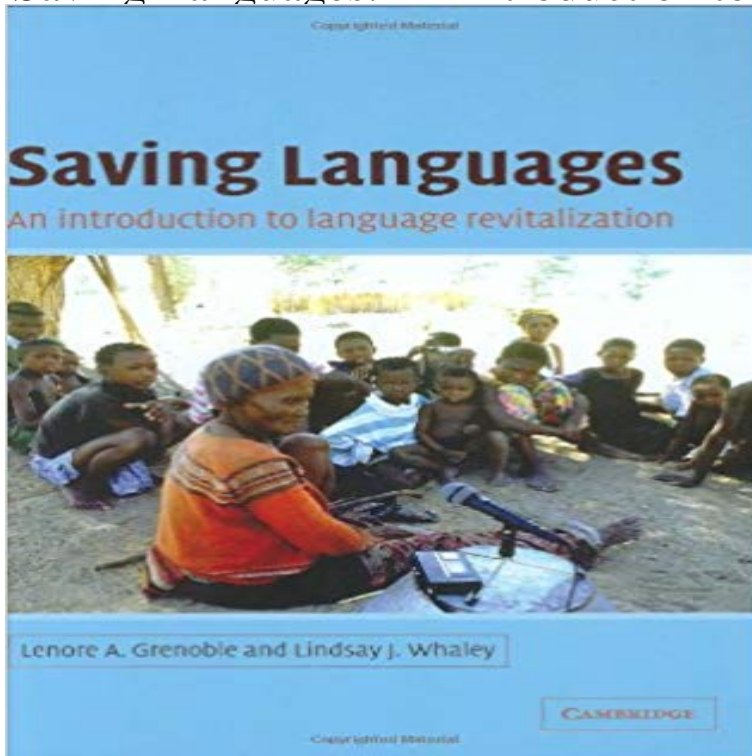


Saving Languages: An Introduction to Language Revitalization
