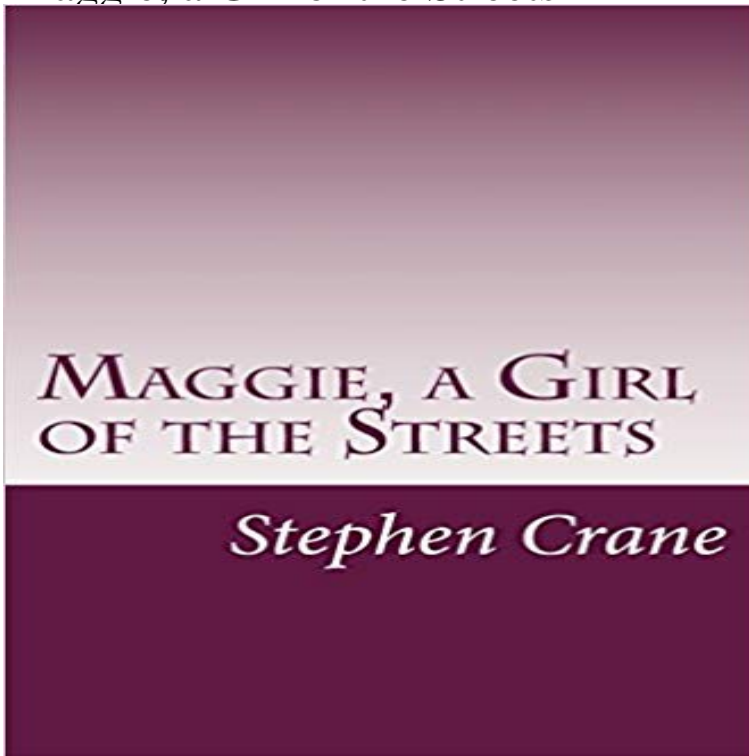


Maggie, a Girl of the Streets
