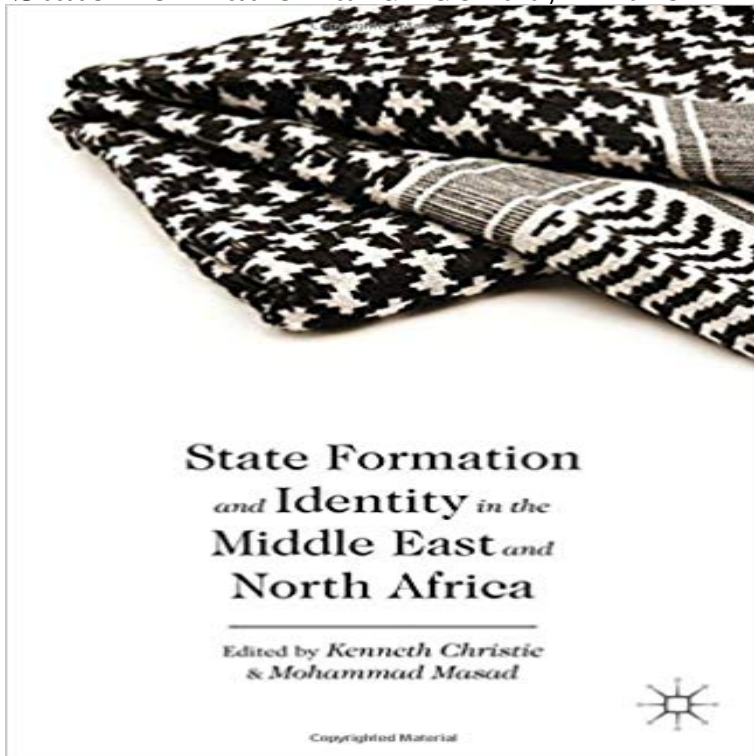


State Formation and Identity in the Middle East and North Africa
