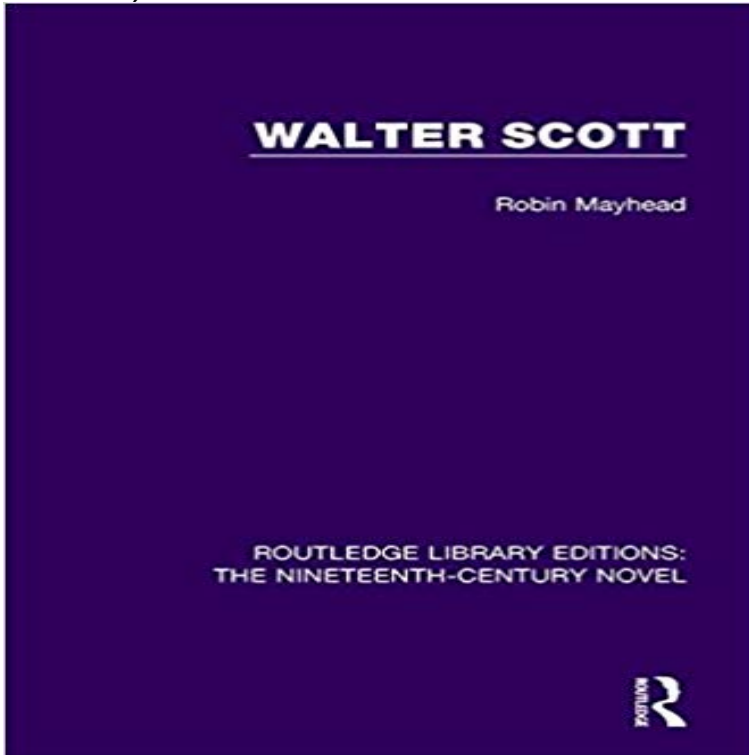


# Walter Scott (Routledge Library Editions: The Nineteenth-Century Novel)

The use of literary conventions of the time is examined with reference to Scotts work and extracts exemplify in particular the use of the Heroic. While admitting Scotts faults as a writer, the author presents a general view of him as one whose works deserve deeper study than was the prevailing opinion at the time. This book will be of interest to students of literature.
