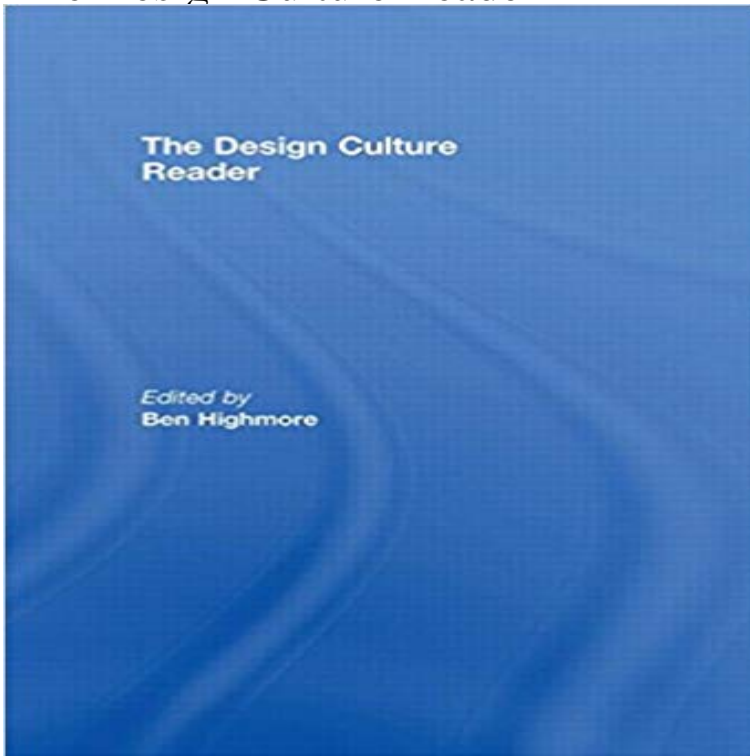


# The Design Culture Reader
