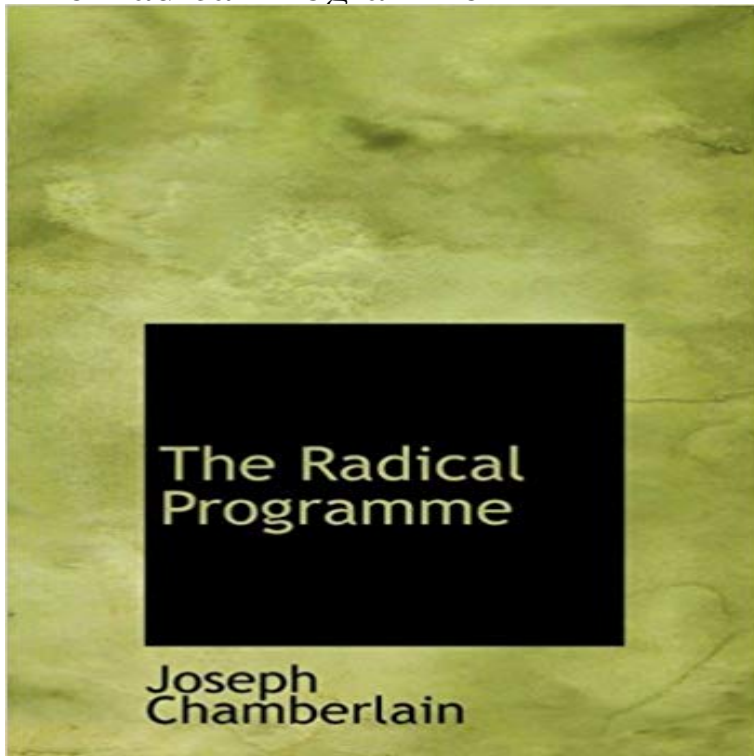


# The Radical Programme
