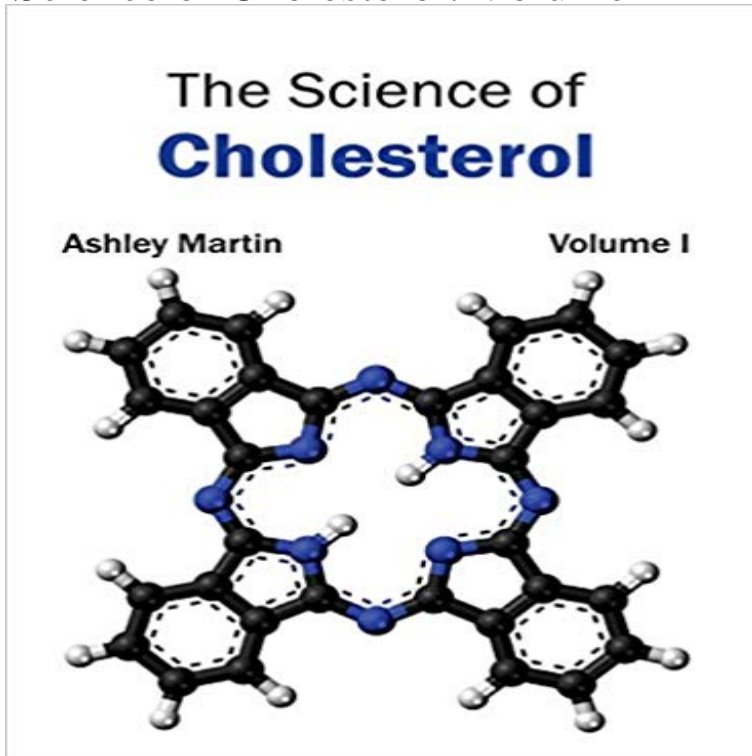


Science of Cholesterol: Volume I
