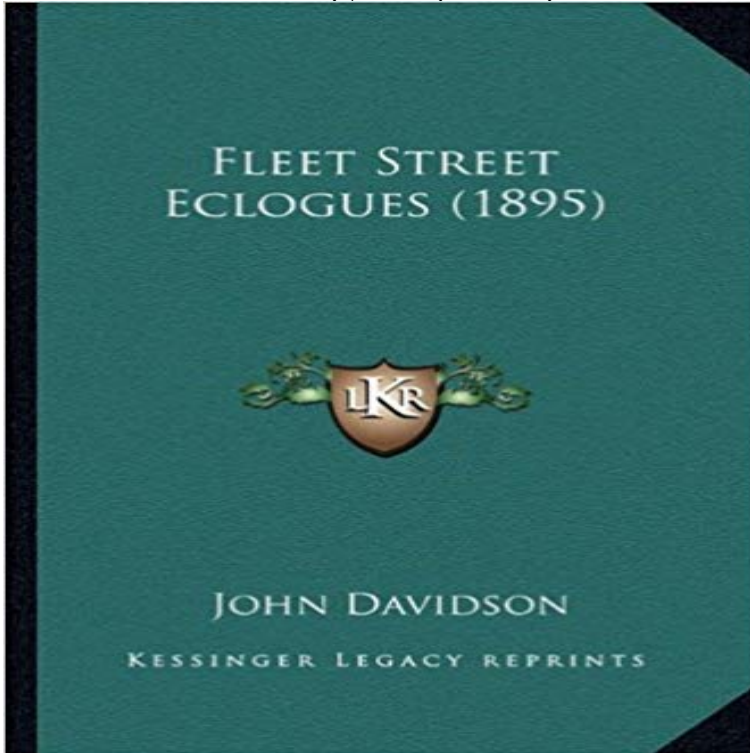


Fleet Street Eclogues (1895)
