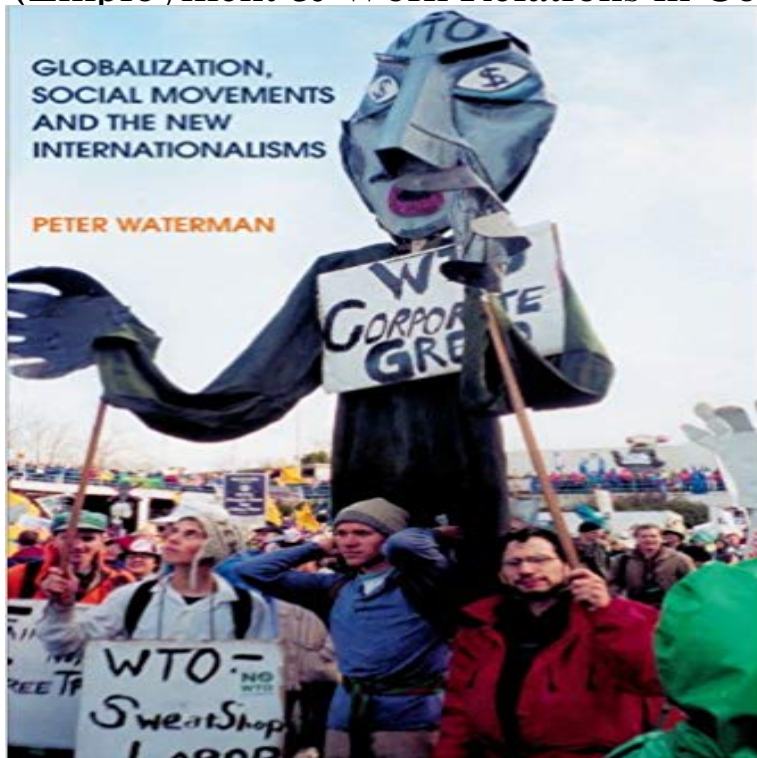


## Globalization, Social Movements and the New Internationalisms (Employment & Work Relations in Context)

It argues for a new global solidarity that relates to a radicalized, globalized, informatized and complex capitalist modernity. This new internationalism addresses multiple global social problems and democratic movements. It both learns from the social theories of today and provides a necessary complement to them.
