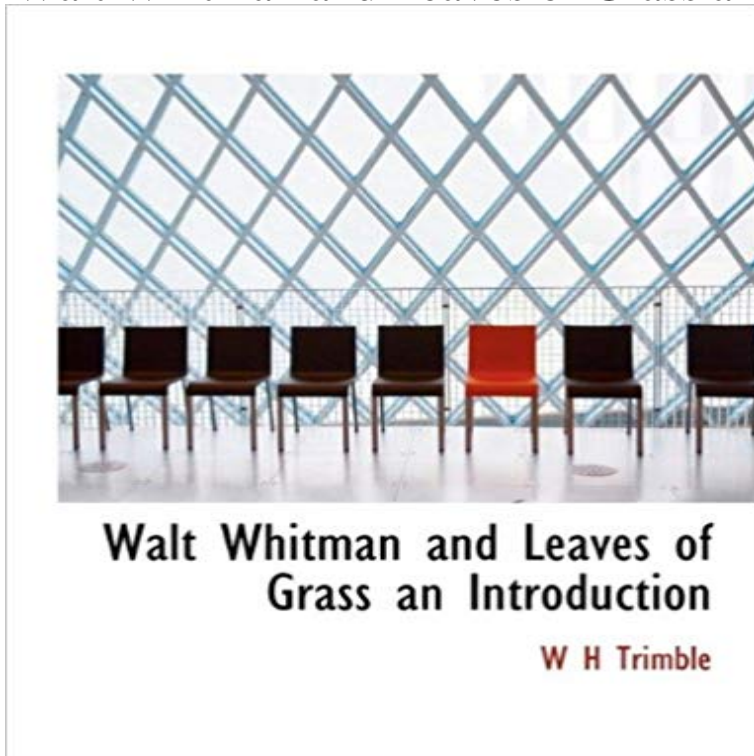


Walt Whitman and Leaves of Grass an Introduction
